

## Share the Road Mini Grants

Through the sale of 'Share the Road' specialty license plates, Bike Florida has established mini-grants to provide funds for programs that focus on motorist and bicycle education and awareness of proper, legal roadway sharing. This grant program will not fund helmet purchase and distribution programs, brochure printing or promotional items (i.e. t-shirts or reflective items) since other funding sources are available for these programs. Preference will be given to efforts that the review committee determines will garner significant media coverage. Provocative approaches are encouraged. Organizations interested in applying for a mini-grant should understand and be willing to meet the following criteria:

### TERMS OF MINI-GRANT AWARD

The applying organization understands and accepts the conditions set forth by Bike Florida:

1. Applicant may apply for grants from \$200 to \$2,000 per year. There is no assurance that the exact amount specified in the grant proposal will be awarded to the applicant.
2. A match of equivalent or more dollars and/or in-kind contributions is required to receive grant funds. A detailed proposal of the funding sources for the match and expenditures shall be provided.
3. Applicant will use the funds only as specified in the application.
4. Applicant agrees to help publicize and recognize the 'Share the Road' specialty license plate and Bike Florida for their support of the grantee's program.
5. Applicant agrees to provide a program progress report within six months from the receipt of the grant funds and a final report at the conclusion of the project within 12 months of receipt of the grant funds.
