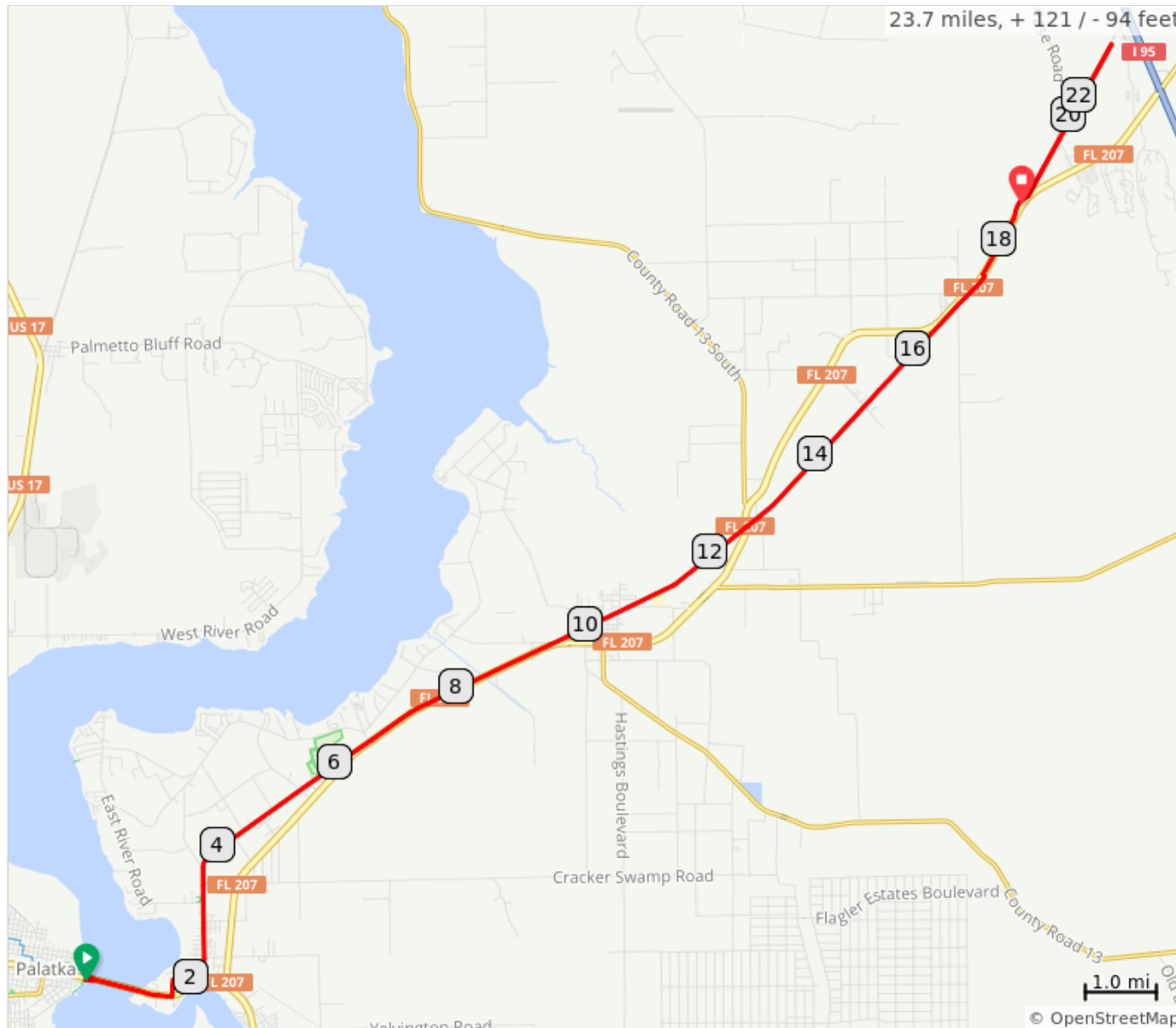


# Palatka to St. Augustine State Trail



The Palatka-to-St. Augustine State Trail is a multi-use recreational trail along a corridor that stretches through St. Johns and Putnam counties.

This 12-foot-wide, 19-mile-long paved trail runs through beautiful agricultural landscapes and scenic routes. You can begin your adventure from several access points. Starting in St. Johns County and traveling into Putnam County tends to be the popular route due to the ample parking at the eastern trailheads and the opportunity to visit the designated Florida Trail Town of Palatka mid-trip.

Num	Dist	Type	Note
1.	0.0	📍	Start of route
2.	0.0	➔	Right and follow the boardwalk under the bridge.
3.	0.2	➡	Sharp left onto US-17 N
4.	1.5	➡	Left onto Masters Rd
5.	1.7	➔	Right onto Ferry Rd
6.	2.2	⬆	Continue onto Putnam County Blvd
7.	5.4	<i>i</i>	Jim Bryant Rd
8.	8.1	<i>i</i>	Rector Rd
9.	9.1	<i>i</i>	The county line is at Merryfield Ln where County Line Produce is.
10.	9.4	<i>i</i>	The trail is finished to here as of November 2015. There is now only a 3.2 mile gap between the two brown POIs.

Num	Dist	Type	Note
11.	12.6	<i>i</i>	Will cross SR 207 and connect to previously finished trail that goes 8.5 more miles.
12.	15.0	⬆	ARMSTRONG
13.	17.4	➡	Left to cross SR 207
14.	19.6	<i>i</i>	Last exit before dead-end. But it's a beautiful 1.5 miles in the woods.
15.	23.7	📍	End of route

14.2 miles. +53/-31 feet
